2. Confirmation of notes of previous KCCCC meeting of 14 September 2023 and Actions arising

3. Master Plan

3.1 Master Plan Review

- Final version of the KCCCC summary brochure including artwork has been printed and distributed at Callington Show and last KCCCC meeting.

4. Kanmantoo Copper Mine

Glenn Norris provided the following updates.

4.1 Compliance / Emission / Rehabilitation

- No new compliance issues during the last quarter.
- Continue to monitor dust, surface water, ground water, soil, flora, fauna, landowners bores.
- Continuous dust monitors set up and being used for live monitoring. Discussion around how source of dust is identified ie DEM and EPA regulated sites. Hillgrove must submit a report irrespective of the source of dust if an exceedance occurs at one of the monitors. This report considers other possible sources of dust.
- Baseline noise monitoring conducted.
- Revegetated areas being maintained on-site and off-site including seed harvesting and processing, spot spraying, hand weeding and slashing high quality revegetated areas, pest management.
- Independent flora and fauna surveys conducted in October and November.
- Hillgrove has supplied seed from ~ 30 species to GWLAP for use in the Callington Native Vegetation Project. This seed was sourced from site.
- Annual Monitoring and Rehabilitation Compliance Report being compiled.

4.2 Kanmantoo Underground

Glenn Norris gave a presentation on the progress of the Kanmantoo Underground project. Updates Since last meeting.

- Development mining (tunnels) approximately 1,600m advance total. Increased to 500 m per month now that a second jumbo is on site.
- Primary vent raise completed.
- Primary vent fans have been installed.
- 1st egress raise has been bored.
- Majority of water has been pumped from the bottom of the open pit.
- Haulage of development ore to the ROM pad has commenced.
- Three diamond drill rigs continue to drill underground.
- Recruitment of the workforce has ramped up.
- New exploration target identified on the mine lease and adjacent area.
- The next quarter will see production drilling, stope ore production, processing plant testing and refurbishment and copper production.

- ASX releases (x 3) Kanmantoo Deeps Exploration Target, Underground Confirmation Drilling Results, Primary Ventilation Commissioned

However, the MasterPlan could be used to support individual resident submissions, although it is in need of an update. It was noted that Fiona's health was preventing her from leading this process.
