Recently the KCCCC has been considering the mine's Closure and Completion Plan with a view to promoting the best possible outcome for the community from this process. The KCCCC has established a Master Planning Working Party for this purpose and the group has submitted its early work to DCMB for information as the Council prepares its draft Strategic Plan.

The KCCCC response to the Mt Barker 2035 draft District Strategic Plan will focus mainly on the matters related to mine closure that we have been considering in the Master Planning Working Party. The KCCCC would like to ensure that as many community members as possible have a chance to contribute to the KCCCC response so the following process has been designed:

- 1. KCCCC members will seek the views of members of the community and provide comments on the draft DCMB Strategic Plan to the Chair. These comments will be compiled into a single draft response
- 2. This draft response will be placed on the agenda of the next KCCCC meeting which will be held on the 10th December 2015 to ensure that the community is well informed and involved
- 3. Discussion of the draft response will be encouraged at the KCCCC meeting and any additional input will be recorded
- 4. Greg Sarre from the DCMB will be invited to attend the KCCCC meeting
- 5. The KCCCC response will be finalised and forwarded to DCMB as soon as possible after the KCCCC meeting

The key questions of the online questionnaire are:

- 1. Do you agree with the Objectives and Strategies of the draft Plan?
- 2. Are the community issues identified in the Plan the right ones for your community?
- 3. Are the priorities identified under each Goal Area the right ones?
- 4. What would you like to improve in the draft plan?
- 5. Do you have any other comments?
